Moana Jr. History

Disney released the movie *Moana* in 2016 to much success. Millions of viewers have been charmed by its depiction of real tradition and heritage of the Polynesian cultures. In creating the original film, the producers at Disney Animation formed an Oceanic Trust. This group of historians anthropologists, cultural practitioners, linguists, and choreographers from islands including Samoa, Tahiti, Mo'orea, and Fiji was integral in the creation of the film, providing feedback and notes on character design, song lyrics, and the depiction of culture onscreen.

In the movie, set around 3,000 years ago on the fictional island of Motunui, Moana must find her place and her way. Moana uses techniques that have been used for thousands of years by Polynesian voyagers. Wayfinding involves several methods of navigating. For example, navigators would watch for changes in the waves and swells of the ocean. They would observe the flight patterns of birds to find the direction of land. And of course, they would measure the stars to find their position.

Evidence of Pacific islands exploration exists that leads historians and anthropologists to believe that the mass exploration of the Pacific Ocean began in earnest over 3,500 years ago. Evidence also shows that there was a halt to this exploration for a 2000 year period which is known as "The Long Pause." It is in this timeframe that the story of *Moana* is set.

Polynesian mythology is referenced throughout the movie, especially with the depiction of Maui. Because legends vary across the islands, the version of Maui in *Moana* is not a precise portrayal of any one version of him but many of the best Polynesian stories added together.

Polynesian language and names are found in the movie also. Moana's name means "ocean" in many Polynesian languages. Tala (the name of Moana's grandma) means "story" in Samoan. "We Know the Way" features lyrics in both Samoan and Tokelauan, a Polynesian language spoken by only about 3000 people in the world today.

As a coming of age tale, the real core of Moana's story is centered around Family. Family is an important part of the Polynesian culture. Moana starts out confused and conflicted about her place in her village and in her family. As she realizes that there is more to the story of her family, including her voyaging ancestors, she begins to find her place.

We hope you enjoy the stage adaptation of the story of *Moana* on stage today. The traditions and storytelling of the Pacific Islands have brought beauty and joy to our program. It has been a pleasure to watch our students bring such rich culture and heritage to life.
